Tech Met, Inc. receives a \$1,000,000 grant from Pennsylvania's Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program

Glassport, PA – September 2018, Tech Met, Inc, an employee-owned manufacturing business specializing in standard and custom milling, received a \$1,000,000 grant administered by Pennsylvania's Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP).

The RACP is a Commonwealth grant program administered by the Office of the Budget for the acquisition and construction of regional economic, cultural, civic, recreational, and historical improvement projects. Tech Met will use the grant to fund new technology investment and production expansion at their new site in Donora Borough, Washington County.

Tech Met purchased the 88,275 sq. ft. building on 6+ acres to expand their existing Glassport, PA business in 2016 to support new technologies and an increasing customer base. Since then, over \$4M of building renovations and equipment has been invested in Donora.

Tech Met President Mike Vidra said, "Investment will continue as new production lines are installed to expand Tech Met's business footprint into additional high-tech aerospace, military and medical areas". Vidra added that Tech Met anticipates hiring 20-30 employees over the next five years, with 90% of those positions expected at the Donora facility.
